IMPORTANT POLICIES:

Students need to try to use the restroom before coming into class. This helps to not take up class time to go to the restroom. There will be NO FOOD allowed in the dance rooms at any time. Water is the only drink allowed in the dance rooms and it must be in a sealable container (ex. - water bottle with lid or cup with lid). This is to help keep the dance floors protected from accidents. When students arrive at class they need to be completely ready before the class begins. Please be in appropriate dress for the class attending (according to dress code in the brochure or on the website). Hair must be pulled back into a bun or pony tail. The first violation of the dress code will result in a Warning. For the second violation, the student will be asked to sit out during class.

Once class has started & the teacher closes the door, please DO NOT enter the classroom if unnecessary. Teachers & assistants will attempt to calm any scared/nervous/upset students. If they are not successful, your child will then be brought to you.
